Award for

“Incredible Bravery”

Mr. T. D. Archibald, Bosun's Mate of the *Stirling Castle*, has been awarded by Her Majesty The Queen the Silver Medal for Gallantry at Sea—the highest peacetime award for courage that a civilian can receive. The medal has also been awarded posthumously to Mr. J. MacIver, Deckhand.

Readers will recall the ready action of Mr. MacIver in swimming to the aid of a seaman who jumped overboard whilst being brought to England in the *Stirling Castle* last September. The waters were shark-infested and when he saw his friend was in difficulties Mr. Archibald immediately dived in and swam to his assistance but Mr. MacIver did not recover from injuries inflicted by the sharks. The D.B.S. was rescued unharmed.
