



The Last Voyage of the *Drakensberg Castle*

THIS pictorial record of places and sights not normally seen by Union-Castle personnel has been sent us by Roland Jacques, Chief Officer of the *Drakensberg Castle* for her last voyage. As reported last time, the vessel was recently sold to breakers in Hong Kong.



The picture *top left*, taken at Antwerp, he has entitled "Three Blind Mice" because none of the Officers had previously been out to Shanghai. Just visible, from left to right, are Third Officer Roger Wilson, Second Officer Dennis France and Chief Officer Roland Jacques.
