The Ship Canal terminates at Manchester where there are 8 docks with a water space of 129 acres. The largest dock. No. 9, is 2,700 ft. long and 250 ft. wide. Of the subsidiary dock systems along the Canal Stanlow Oil Docks is outstanding. It is situated near the entrance to the Mersey and is recognized as Britain's greatest oil nort Another important section of the Canal is Ellesmere Port. 3 miles from the entrance, with the important chemical plants in the vicinity. The main coaling basin is at Partington, where there are 6 tips and 20 acres of quays, and along the whole length of the Canal there are lay-byes and wharves for general traffic.
