The Rothesay Castle, one of two new refrigerated cargo liners for the Union-Castle Line, was launched by Lady Cayzer at the Cartsdyke Yard of the Greenock Dockyard Co. Ltd. on 30th December, 1959.

The Rothesay Castle is the second of a new type of vessel ordered by the Company, and her sister ship, the Rotherwick



Castle, launched last August, completed her sea trials and sailed from Middlesbrough on 29th December for the Continent. She left London for African ports on 13th January.
