New Year Honours List

We record with pleasure that Dr. Robert Augustus Newsom was made an M.B.E. in the New Year Honours List.

Dr. Newsom, who retired in October, 1962, joined the Union-Castle Line in September, 1950, as Surgeon of the *Durban Castle*: he transferred to the *Carnarvon Castle* a year later and from 1953 until his retirement was Surgeon of the Canetown Castle.

Dr. Nessom has always been particularly interested in the health of Merchant Seamen and one of his appointments, after qualifying, was House Surgeon of the Seament's Hospital, Greenwich. His career has also taken him to Rhodesia, where he served for 15 years as Medical Officer with the Rhodesia and nine years as part-time Railway Medical Officer with the Rhodesian Railways, followed by three years; in General Practice in Southern Rhodesia.

Dr. Newsom was Surgeon in charge when the explosion occurred on the Capetown Castle in October, 1960. purchased by Marivic Navigation Inc. of Monrovia, Liberia, on 31st December.
