New Cargo Liner will be the most Powerful Afloat

**H.R.H. PRINCESS ALEXANDRA** received a tumultuous reception when she arrived at Wallsend on 20th October to name the *Southampton Castle*.

This latest addition to the fleet took the water to resounding cheers from shipworkers and their families and to a chorus of ship's hooters and whistles.

The Rt. Rev. K. E. N. Lamplugh, Suffragan Bishop of Southampton, conducted the launching service and

at the celebration that followed the Princess declared "I have no doubt that the *Southampton Castle* will enjoy a happy relationship with the great seaport whose name she bears, where ships of the Union-Castle Line have been for so many years a familiar feature of the horizon."

When she is completed in April, 1965, the *Southampton Castle* will be the most powerful non-passenger carrying cargo liner afloat.
