

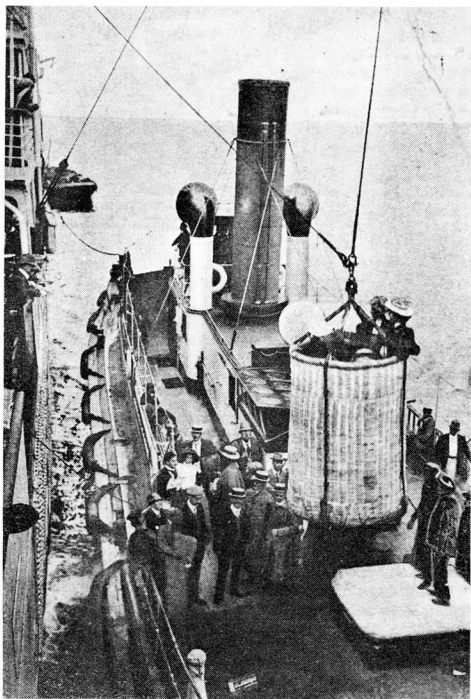

Mrs. Connie James, wife of Captain J. B. James, presently in command of the *Reina del Mar*, has sent this post-card depicting passengers undertaking the transfer from ship to tug preparatory to landing at East London in the early 1930's.

Mrs. James, Snr., whose husband, the late Captain J. S. James, D.S.C., was then in command of the *Dromore Castle*, journeyed to visit her son in East London in the old *Windsor Castle*, wives not being permitted to sail with their husbands in those days. She was advised to stay on board until the last “basketful” as the sea was rough and the tug was bobbing about like a cork on the water.
