

The Braemar Castle has been sold for breaking up to Shipbreaking Industries Limited and was delivered to her buyers at Faslane (Gare Lock), River Clyde, on Thursday, 6th January, The youngest of three "sister" ships, Bruemar Castle, 17,024 tons, was built and engined at Belfast by Harland A. Wolff Ltd. in 1952. She saw much service on the East African coast
