LONGER

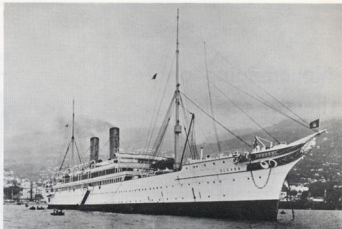
Sir,
